**Overview:** *One Acquisition Solution for Integrated Services Plus* (OASIS+) is a suite of government-wide, multi-award contracts designed to support federal agencies' procurement requirements for services-based solutions. This suite of services contracts is available for use by agencies throughout the Federal Government who hold a Delegation of Procurement Authority (DPA).

**Overview:** OASIS+ is a collection of multiple-award, Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contracts, of which the contract base period is five (5) years with one (1) option period of five (5) years that may extend the cumulative contract ordering period to 10 years. Task orders can be awarded under OASIS+ any time prior to the expiration of the ordering period of the master contracts. OASIS+ contracts may be used by all federal agencies, including the Department of Defense (DoD) and Federally Funded Research and Development Centers (FFRDCs), but they are not currently open to state and local governments.

**Next Phase Capabilities**

**Management and Advisory Domain:** This Domain includes a full range of management and consulting services that can improve a federal agency's performance, its endeavors to meet mission goals, and provide operating advice and assistance on administrative and management issues.

**Technical and Engineering Domain:** This Domain includes requirements to provide specific engineering, geoscience, or other technical professional skills, such as those performed by engineers, geologists, geophysicists, and technicians, required to handle specific operating conditions and problems for the benefit of the Government. Work under this Domain typically involves the application of physical laws and principles of engineering in the design, development, and utilization of machines, materials, instruments, processes, and systems; and providing expert advice and assistance on technical functions and issues.
